## The Child Find Repository



## The Child Find Repository


- The Child Find Repository is an online listing of Child Find students who are not enrolled in a public school.
- These students have a STUDENT STATUS = 'C'.
- The purpose of the Child Find Repository is to document the status of 'C' Child Find students (Child Find Students not enrolled in your public school).
- It is located in the GaDOE portal under the FTE Main Menu for FTE-1 and FTE-3.







Updating the Child Find Repository is a three-step process.





## **'C' Child Find Student Reporting Process during the FTE-1 Cycle**

### **Upload FTE-1** Data File

- The following students should be uploaded in the FTE-1 Data File:
  - All New 'C' Child Find Students
  - Service Plan Students (IEP SERVICES = 'S')
  - Students who exited the LEA since FTE-1 prior year (Any withdrawals since FTE-1 of the prior year)
  - Students whose current CHILD FIND STATUS in the repository is incorrect
    - This includes student who need to be removed from the Child Find Repository
  - NEW students whose IEP SERVICES = 'N'



### **Upload FTE-1 Data File**

#### Important Note about Returning 'C' Child Find Students

- Students with a **STUDENT STATUS** = 'C' and **IEP SERVICES** = 'S' must be reported (all required fields) <u>every year</u> because you are serving them.
- Students with a **STUDENT STATUS** = 'C' and **IEP SERVICES** = 'N' must be reported in their <u>first year only</u>. In subsequent years, these students will be in the repository and do not have to be reported from the SIS if there are no changes to the **STUDENT STATUS** or **IEP STATUS**.



## Step 3: Update the CHILD FIND STATUS in FTE-1

- Update the data elements for 'C' Child Find Students uploaded in the FTE-1 data file through your SIS for FTE-1.
- CHILD FIND STATUS is only reported for 'C' Child Find Students.

**Note:** Not served students (**IEP SERVICES** = 'N') in the Child Find Repository during FTE-1 should be uploaded in FTE-1 to remove them from the Child Find Repository if the student no longer belongs to your LEA.

### What's Next: Repeat Step 1

- After December 1, when the Child Find Repository reopens, LEAs will be able to update the Child Find Repository.
- All 'C' Child Find Students added in FTE-1 and in the Repository at sign-off will be added to the FT085 Report.
- Prior to FTE sign-off, review the FT085 report for accuracy.

## FT059A Report: Current Child Find Student Detail

- This report includes ONLY ERROR-FREE students aged 3-21 enrolled in private or home school and reported only for federal child count purpose with a Student Status of "C" (Federal Child Count).
- This report does not include students in the Repository.
- During the FTE-1 collection, the data is refreshed during each FTE validation.
- After FTE-1 sign-off, the report is static.



## FT059A Report: Current Child Find Student Detail

- This report contains the 'C' Child Find students the LEA is uploading in FTE-1.
- All students are 'C' Child Find students in the FT059A.
- All students have a REPORT TYPE of 'S' in the FT059A.
- PRIMARY AREA varies by student.
- IEP SERVICES is 'N' (Not Served) or 'S' (Services Plan).
- WITHDRAWAL CODES are 'H' (Home school), 'K' (transferred to a (non-profit) private school), or 'Z' (SB10 private (non-profit) school transfer).

- This Report applies to FTE-1 and includes students aged 3-21 enrolled in private or home school and reported only for federal child count purpose with a STUDENT STATUS = 'C' (Federal Child Count).
- This report lists students who have been previously identified as **STUDENT STATUS** = 'C' from the FTE 2021-1 through FTE 2023-1 data collections.
- If a student is no longer a 'C' Child Find student, STUDENT STATUS = 'C', districts should upload the student in FTE-1 and select the appropriate CHILD FIND STATUS.
- During the FTE-1 collection, the data is refreshed during each FTE validation.
- After FTE-1 sign-off, the report is static.



The Overdue Eligibilities and IEPs application provides a list of SWD whose last reported eligibility is more than 3 years ago and/or last reported IEP is more than one year old. The list also includes students whose age is over 9 and the primary area is SDD.



## Overdue Eligibilities and IEPs

If the LEA has students listed in the Overdue Eligibilities and IEPs application, then your district should:

- Respond to the Overdue Eligibilities and IEPs data request in the application.
- Upload documentation of the completed eligibility and/or IEP.


