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
Office of Federal Programs






LEA-Level Inset Map FY23




Staff per 1,000 Students (FTE)


FY24 Where does Georgia stand?

School Psychologists (CPI Job Codes: 404, 405)

The National Association of School Psychologists⁴ recommends a ratio of 500:1. **The Georgia statewide school psychologist student-staff ratio improved from 2,428:1 in 2017 to 2,150:1 in 2024.**



- In 2024, 788 full-time equivalent school psychologist positions serve Georgia students. LEAs added 82 full-time equivalent school psychologist positions from 2017 to 2024.
- In 2024, 44 of 180 LEAs (24%) did not have a school psychologist.
- No LEAs currently meet the recommended student-staff ratio of 500:1.


