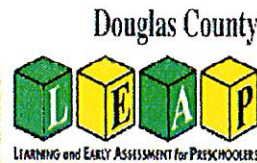

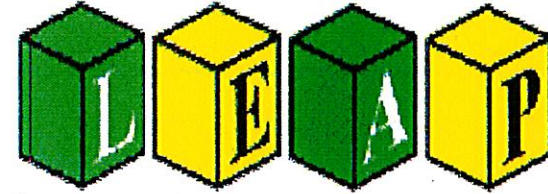

To be eligible for services a child must:

Reside in Douglas County

& Be between the ages of 3—5

& Exhibit a significant delay in one or more of the following:

- Cognition / Early Learning Skills
- Speech/Language Skills
- Daily-Living Skills
- Fine Motor / Gross Motor Skills
- Social / Emotional / Behavior Skills
- Vision / Hearing Skills
